MISSION STATEMENT

To provide regulation in an equitable manner to New Mexico's pari-mutuel horseracing industry to protect the interest of wagering patrons and the State of New Mexico in a manner which promotes a climate of economic prosperity for horsemen, horse owners and racetrack management.

HISTORY OF THE COMMISSION

The Horse Racing Act (HRA) was enacted in 1938, allowing horse racing and pari-mutuel wagering in New Mexico, the Commission oversees compliance with the HRA.

The statute authorizes the Racing Commission to enforce and administer the statutes by allowing for the creation and enforcement of rules and regulations pertaining to horseracing.

The Racing Commission is authorized under the authority of 60-1A-1 through 60-1A-30, NMSA 1978. The statute mandates the Agency to regulate and enforce the statutes and rules and regulations of the horseracing industry. The statute authorizes a five-member commission appointed by the governor and approved by the senate. The current FTE is 23.

By statutory authority, the Commission must closely work with the horseracing industry to ensure the integrity of the industry. Patrons at the racetracks rely on the Commission so they may confidently place wagers on horses in races conducted within the state.

The Racing Commission's work and activities includes the following:

- Licensing of all racing participants
- Oversight and judgment of races and racetrack operations
- Testing of selected horses for drug detection
- Investigation and enforcement of rule and regulation infractions
- Testing of pari-mutuel pay-outs
- Oversight of racetrack financial obligations
- Oversight of racetracks' capability and viability to operate a race meet
- Promote and support the economic and viability of the horseracing industry within the State

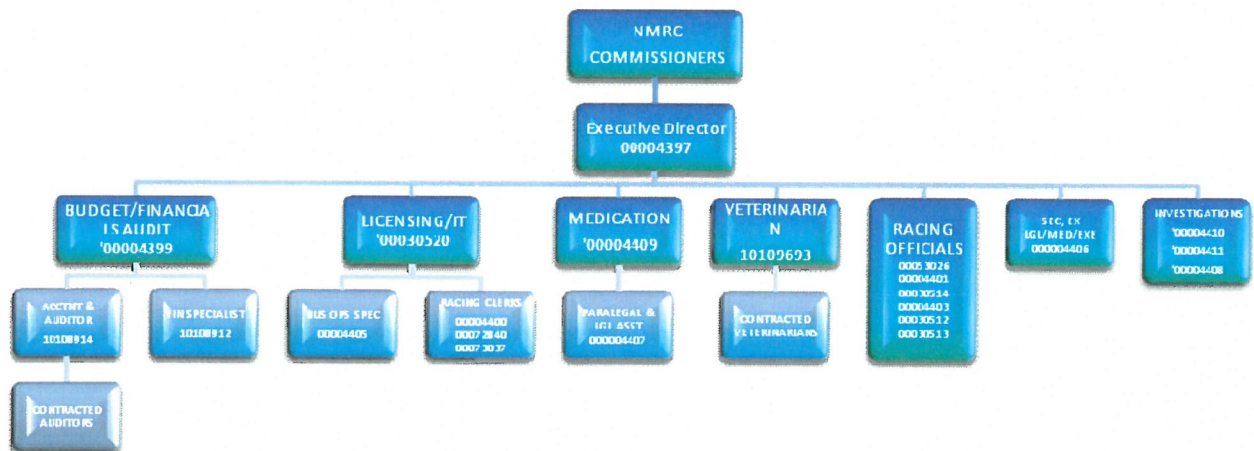
EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

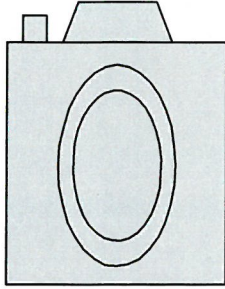

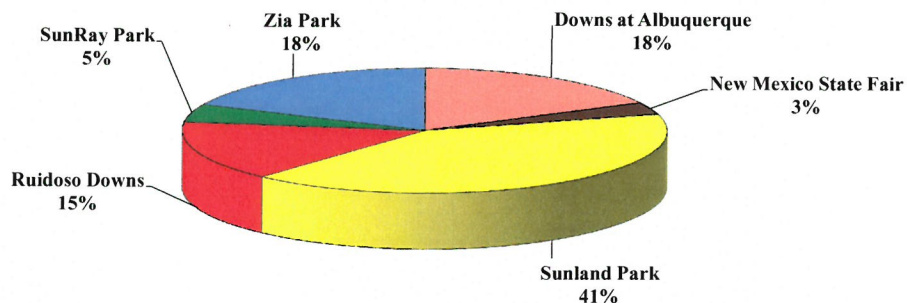

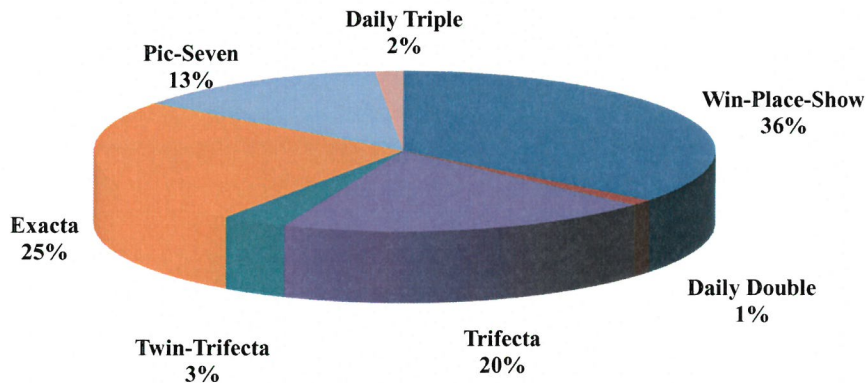

Trends in Wagering 2017



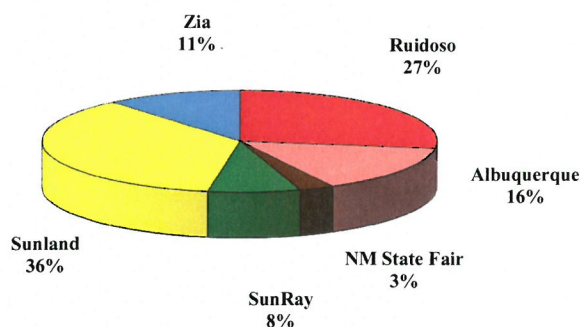

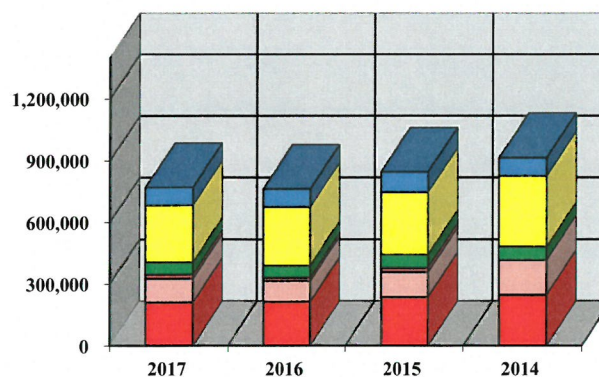

Attendance by Race Meet



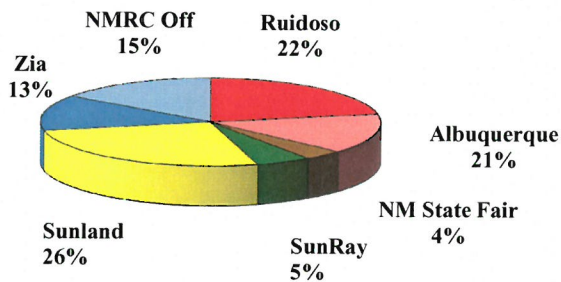

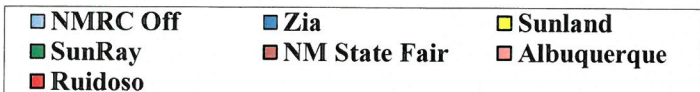

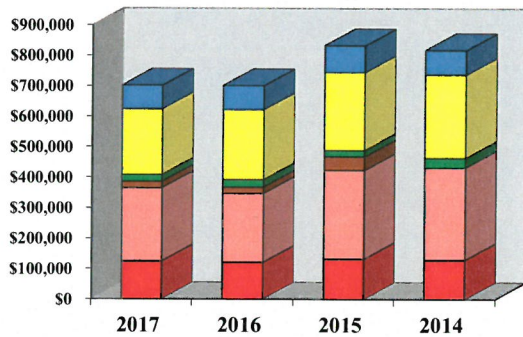
State Revenues



WAGER AND DISTRIBUTION LOCATION TOTALS

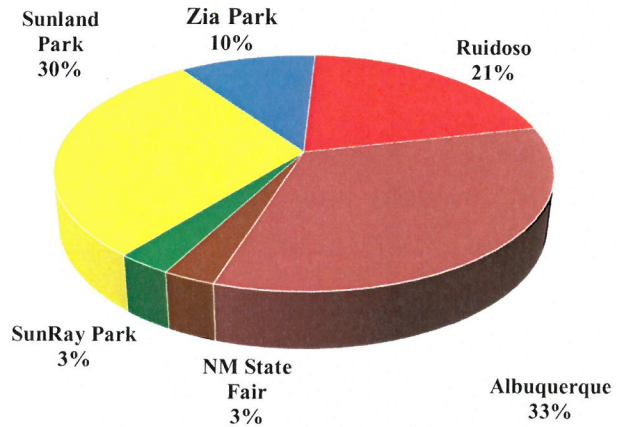

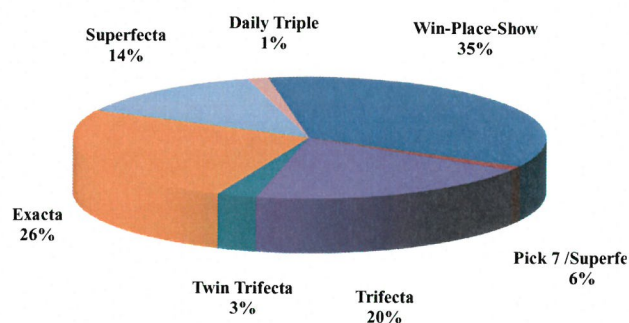

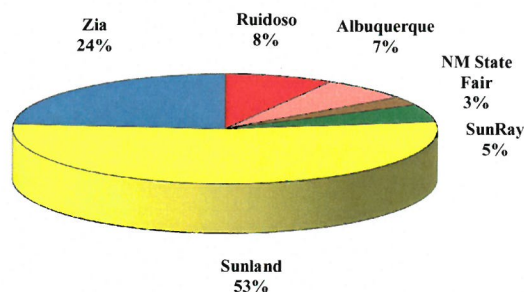

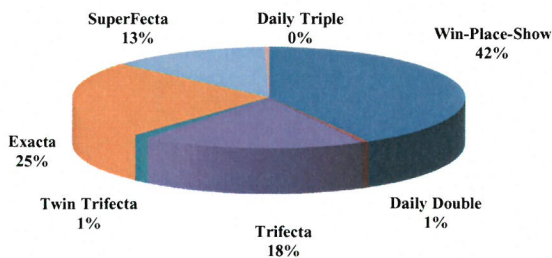

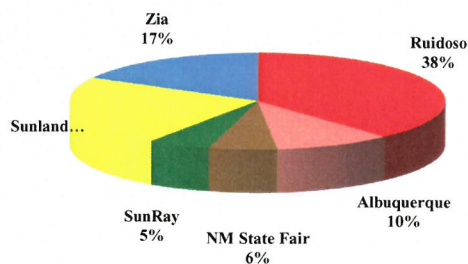

Rules with an effective date of September 15, 2016 are as follows:

- * ***Amendment to 15.2.1.9 NMAC*** – The following changes were made:
 1. Subsection B (*Due Process and Disciplinary Action*) Paragraph (3)(d) amended to reference correct Subsection.
- * ***Amendment to 15.2.3.8 NMAC*** – The following changes were made:
 1. Subsections B (*Flat Racing Officials General Provisions*) Paragraph (9)(a) removal of a duplicate word and insert new language at end of sentence.
 2. Subsection N (*Official Veterinarian*) Paragraph (10) amended to reference correct Subsection.
 3. Subsection O (*Racing Veterinarian*) new Paragraph (6).
- * ***Amendment to 15.2.4.8 NMAC*** – The following changes were made:
 1. Subsection A (*General Provisions*) Paragraph (4) was amended to reference correct Subsection.
- * ***Amendment to 15.2.5.12 NMAC*** – The following changes were made:
 1. Subsections B and Z were amended.
- * ***Amendment to 15.2.6.9 NMAC*** – The entire section was amended by removing subsections, re-letter subsections and changes within 15.2.6.9. Two ARCI reference documents have been updated and are included.

Rules with an effective date of December 16, 2016 are as follows:

- * ***Amendment to 15.2.1.9 NMAC*** - The following changes were made to Subsection B (*Proceedings Before the Stewards*):
 1. In Paragraph (2)(a) verbiage regarding Class 1 and 2 drug violations going straight to the hearing officer was removed. All cases will go before the stewards.
 2. In Paragraph (3)(b) a summary suspension hearing will be held within 10 days instead of 3 days.
 3. In Paragraph (7)(b) a ruling will no longer include the date of birth but will include the applicant ID number for licensees.

4. Filing requirement changes were made to Subsection C (Proceedings by the Commission) in Paragraphs (1)(c), (2)(a), and (7)(a).

* **Amendment to 15.2.2.8 NMAC** - The following changes were made to Subsection B (*Proceedings Before the Stewards*):

1. In Subsection R (*Fire Prevention*) Paragraphs (3) and (4) were amended.

* **Amendment to 15.2.3.8 NMAC** - The following changes were made:

1. In Subsection B (*Stewards*) Paragraph (4)(e) was added and numerous filing requirements changes were done.
2. Filing requirement changes were made to Subsections C, D, F, I and O.

* **Amendment to 15.2.4.8 NMAC**

1. In Subsection B (*Claiming options*) Paragraph (1), subparagraph (c) was added.
2. In Subsection E (*Prohibitions*) Paragraph (5) was added.
3. In Subsection G (*Transfer or Claimed Horses*) filing requirement changes were made.

* **Amendment to 15.2.5.8 NMAC**

1. In Subsection B (*Procedure*) Paragraph (2) “a licensed designee...” was replaced with “an assistant trainer”.

* **Amendment to 15.2.5.11 NMAC**
