Jockey Jose Chavez, was duly notified and appeared before the Board of Stewards on July 27, 2019. The hearing was in regard to Jose Chavez's excessive use of the whip on his mount "Eye Am a Hottie" in the 9th race on July 26, 2019, at the Downs of Albuquerque.

The Board of Stewards hereby fines **Jose Chavez** in the amount of **five hundred dollars (\$500.00)**. The fine is to be paid on or before August 27, 2019, in accordance with 15.2.3.8(B)(3)(K) NMAC. Failure to pay the fine within the time prescribed will result in immediate suspension.

Licensee is found to be in violation of and this ruling is written in accordance with

15.2.5.13(E)(6)(e) Use of riding crops. Indiscriminate use of the whip is prohibited including whipping a horse: on the head, flanks or on any other part of its body other than the shoulders or hind quarters except when necessary to control a horse; during the post parade or after the finish of the race except when necessary to control the horse; excessively or brutally causing welts or breaks in the skin; when the horse is clearly out of the race or has obtained its maximum placing; persistently even though the horse is showing no response under the riding crop; or striking another rider or
