Pat Bingham, New Mexico Horsemen Association (NMHA) Executive Director informed the Commission that at the NMHA monthly meeting held on October 17, 2018 the board came to the conclusion Sports Betting in tribal casinos would be a plus to the tribe's business and would to get support from the public at large and also the horsemen. He stated that he was informed that a Taxation and Revenue meeting was scheduled to be held at the end of October to discuss this subject and the horsemen would be present at this meeting.	Downs at Albuquerque/NMSF they ran 195 NM Bred races during their meets at an average of 3.61 NM Bred races per day, they were plus 33 for their 3 NM Bred races per day requirement and they also averaged 9.07 New Mexico Breds per race. For Zia Park in their first 16 days, they have run 64 NM Bred races per day and are averaging 4 NM Races per day and they are plus 16 for their 3 NM Bred races per day requirement and they are averaging 9.65 New Mexico Breds per race and that is up from 8.67 from last year. She continued to speak about the NM Breds in open races at the Downs at Albuquerque/NMSF 512 NM Breds ran in open overnight races of these 147 came in first, second or third and that's 29%. There were 100 QH and 47 TB. For Zia Park in their first seven days, 50 NM Breds ran in open overnight races, which is 26%; There were 23 QH and 7 TB and that is an average of fewer than 2 per open overnight race of NM Breds running in those races.
