Owner David Diaz-Durante, having been duly notified and having appeared before the Board of Stewards on August 20, 2016, for working for trainer Bart Hone as a groom, a capacity for which he was not licensed on July 24, 2016 at Ruidoso Downs.

<u>David Diaz-Durante</u> was found to be in violation of Commission rules. Thus, for this <u>FIRST</u>

<u>EMPLOYMENT VIOLATION IN A 365 DAY PERIOD WORKING AS A GROOM WITH A VALID</u>

<u>LICENSE IN A CAPACITY IN WHICH HE WAS NOT LICENSED FOR</u>, the Board of Stewards assessed

<u>David Diaz-Durante</u> a penalty in the amount of <u>one hundred dollars (\$100.00)</u>. The fine is to be paid on or before a <u>September 26, 2016</u> in accordance with 15.2.3.8(B)(3)(I) NMAC.

Failure to pay this fine within the time prescribed may result in immediate suspension.

Licensee is found to be in violation of the following rules:

16.47.1.8 L (1)(C) The commission may refuse to issue a license to an applicant, or may suspend or revoke a license issued, or order disciplinary measures, if the applicant: who is unqualified, by experience or otherwise, to perform the activities for which a license is required, or who fails to pass an examination prescribed by the commission.

16.47.1.10 (C)(4) NMAC: Which states in pertinent part "A Trainer must provide a list to the Chief of Security of the Trainer's employees on association grounds and any other area under the jurisdiction of the Commission.

Jockey, <u>Mauro Salcedo</u>, having been summoned and having appeared before the Board of Stewards <u>on</u>

<u>August 26, 2016</u>, for careless riding during the running of the <u>first race on August 22, 2016</u>, <u>at Ruidoso</u>

<u>Downs</u>, while <u>aboard #1 "C.P. Prado"</u> which resulted in the disqualification of his mount from <u>fourth place</u>

<u>to sixth place</u>. (Bore in sharply turning for home coming down on 6 causing him to check and alter course.)

For this violation, the Board of Stewards assessed <u>Mauro Salcedo</u> a suspension of 3 race days (<u>September 3</u>, 2016, <u>September 4</u>, 2016, and <u>September 5</u>, 2016).

Mauro Salcedo is allowed to ride designated races.

This ruling is in accordance with:

15.2.5.13(E)(2)(a) NMAC: which states in pertinent part that "A jockey shall not ride carelessly or willfully so as to permit his/her mount to interfere with, impede or intimidate any other horse in the race."

15.2.5.13(E)(3)(c) NMAC: Which states in pertinent part that "If the Stewards determine the foul was intentional, or due to careless riding, they may fine or suspend the guilty jockey."

15.2.5.13(E)(3)(d) NMAC: Which states in pertinent part that "In a straightaway race, every horse must maintain position as nearly as possible in the lane in which it starts. If a horse is ridden, drifts or swerves out of its lane in such a manner that it interferes with, impedes or intimidates another horse, it is a foul and may result in the disqualification of the offending horse."

Trainer Felipe Flores Jr having been duly notified, failing to appear, and had his hearing held in absentia before the Board of Stewards on August 26, 2016, for missing Lasix and for entry, Current Hero, which resulted in a late scratch and mutuel refund in the first race on August 7, 2016 at Ruidoso Downs.

For this violation, the Board of Stewards assessed Felipe Flores Jr a fine in the amount of two hundred dollars, (\$200.00). The fine is to be paid on or before September 27, 2016, in accordance with 15.2.3.8 (B) (3)(8) NMAC. Failure to pay the fine within the time prescribed may result in immediate suspension Trainer Felipe Flores Jr is found to be in violation of.

- 15.2.6.9(E) (2) The use of furosemide (Salix) shall be permitted under the following circumstances on association grounds where a detention barn is utilized: furosemide (Salix) shall be administered no less than three hours prior to post time for a quarter horse race for which the horse is entered and no less than four hours prior to post time for a thoroughbred race for which a horse is entered. A horse qualified for a furosemide (Salix) administration must be brought to the detention barn one hour prior to the three-hour or four-hour administration requirement specified above. After treatment, the horse shall be required by the commission to remain in the detention barn in the care, custody and control of its trainer or the trainer's designated representative under association or commission security supervision until called to the saddling paddock.
