The summary suspension was in regard to the detection of the Class 2 Penalty A substance, Cardarine (GW501516)/ Cardarine (GW501516) Sulfone, found test sample #E317973 taken from the 2nd place finisher (trained by JIMMY WRIGHT GUERRA), "Major Bites", following the 9th race on May 24, 2019, at Sunray Park Racetrack.

In accordance with 15.2.1.9 (C)(21), JIMMY WRIGHT GUERRA is hereby excluded from all areas of the grounds under the jurisdiction of the NMRC. Additionally, effective upon applicable suspension dates, all horses owned, trained, or under the care of JIMMY WRIGHT GUERRA are ineligible to be entered or start in any race in this jurisdiction, per 15.2.1.9 (C)(21)(c). All transfers and sales of horses trained, owned, or in the care and custody of JIMMY WRIGHT GUERRA must be done in accordance with 15.2.6.9A(12)(a)(b) Medication and Prohibited Substances, 16.47.1.10 (D)(5)Assistant Trainers and 15.2.1.9(B)(8)(b) DUE PROCESS AND DISCIPLINARY ACTION.
