RE: 2018-RUI-10 - Ruling Final Outcome

Groom, Rafael Arellano, (currently summarily suspended) was duly notified, failed to appear, and had his hearing held in absentia, in accordance with 15.2.1.9(B)(4)(d)non-appearance, before the Board of Stewards on June 25, 2018. The hearing was in regard to Rafael Arellano working as a pony person while intoxicated on June 1, 2018, at Ruidoso Downs.

For Rafael Arellano's SECOND violation for intoxication in 365-day period (per Ruidoso Downs exclusion 2017 for intoxication), the Board of Stewards hereby suspends all NMRC licenses belonging to Rafael Arellano for 6 months, June 1, 2018, through November 30, 2018, inclusive (retroactive from the date the summary suspension was issued).

Per 15.2.1.9 (C)(21)(a-b) NMAC, While under suspension, Rafael Arellano is excluded from all areas of the grounds under the jurisdiction of the NMRC.

Licensee is found to be in violation of and this ruling is written in accordance with:

16.47.1.16 (C)(7) Restricted Activities: It shall be an offense to exercise the privileges granted by a license from this commission if the licensee presently has drugs (controlled substances) or alcohol in his/her body. With regard to alcohol, the results of a test showing a reading of more than .05 percent of alcohol in the blood, urine, saliva or other bodily fluids of licensees in non-safety sensitive positions shall be the criterion for a finding of alcohol present in the body. With regard to other controlled substances, presence of the drug in any quantity measured by the testing instrument establishes the presence of the drug for purposes of this paragraph. Licensees in safety sensitive positions, jockeys, starters, assistant starters, exercise riders, pony persons, ambulance personnel, and outriders are in violation of this rule if they have any measurable level of alcohol. 16.47.1.8 (L)(1)(i)Conduct – The Commission may refuse to issue a license to an applicant, or may suspend or revoke a license issued, or order disciplinary measures if the applicant is a person whose conduct or reputation may reflect on the honesty, and integrity of horse racing

16.47.1.19 (C)(1) Second-time offenders: The license of the person may be revoked or suspended for a period of

up to one year or a professional assessment of the person may be ordered by the commission.

16.47.1.19 (C)(3) ASSESSMENT/TREATMENT REQUIREMENTS GENERAL If a professional assessment indicates presence of a treatable problem of alcohol or other drug abuse or dependence, the board of stewards or the commission may order the licensee to undergo treatment as a condition of continuing licensure. Such treatment will be through a program or by a practitioner, acceptable to the licensee and the board of stewards or the commission. Required features of any program or practitioner acceptable to the board of stewards or the commission will be: accreditation or licensure by an appropriate government agency, if required by state statute; a minimum of one year follow-up treatment; and, a formal contract indicating the elements of the treatment and follow-up program that will be completed by the licensee and, upon completion, certified to the board of stewards or the commission as completed. To effect the contract, the licensee will authorize release of information by the treating agency, hospital or
