RE: 2018-RUI-7 - Ruling Final Outcome

Groom April Redlin (currently under summary suspension issued on **May 28, 2018**) was duly notified, failed to appear, and had **her** hearing held in absentia, in accordance with **15.2.1.9(B)(4)(d) non-appearance**, before the Board of Stewards on **June 18, 2018**. The hearing was in concern to **April Redlin** testing positive for **Marijuana (THC), Cocaine, and Methamphetamines** during a drug screening on **May 27, 2018 at Ruidoso Downs**.

The Board of Stewards hereby revoke any/all New Mexico Racing Commission licenses belonging to **April Redlin**, effective immediately **June 18, 2018**. Furthermore, **April Redlin** and is referred to the New Mexico Racing Commission for their further review prior to any further application. **April Redlin** is denied access to all grounds under the jurisdiction of the New Mexico Racing Commission in accordance with 15.2.1.9(C)(21)(a) NMRC.
