The **SunRay Park Board of Stewards** held a hearing for the voided claim of horse **"Eyesa Miracle"** from the **2nd race on April 14, 2017** at **Sunland Park Racetrack**. **Ebert Munoz (trainer)**, **returned the horse "Eyesa Miracle" to the original owner Carlos Queredo..**

Narrative: The trainer Ebert Munoz submitted a claim for the entry "Eyesa Miracle" (a horse in which he had a financial beneficial interest as a trainer) which resulted in the claim being voided.

This ruling is written in accordance with:

15.2.4.8 (A)(3) CLAIMING RACES GENERAL PROVISIONS: The stewards may set aside and order recession of a claim for any horse from a claiming race run in this jurisdiction upon a showing that any party to the claim committed a prohibited action, as specified in Subsection E of 15.2.4 NMAC with respect to the making of the claim, or that the owner of the horse at the time of entry in the claiming race failed to comply with any requirement of these rules regarding claiming races. Should the stewards order a recession of a claim, they may also, in their discretion, make a further order for the costs of maintenance and care of the horse as they may deem appropriate.

15.2.4.8 E. PROHIBITIONS: (1) A person shall not claim a horse in which the person has a financial or beneficial interest as an owner or trainer. **(2)** A person shall not cause another person to claim a horse for the purpose of obtaining or retaining an undisclosed financial or beneficial interest in the horse. **(3)** A person shall not enter into an agreement for the purpose of preventing another person from obtaining a horse in a claiming race.

15.2.4.8(G) (7) TRANSFER OF CLAIMED HORSES: A claimed horse shall not remain in the same stable or under the control or management of its former owner.

For this violation the Board of Stewards assessed Ebert Munoz a penalty as follows: A (\$200.00) two hundred dollar fine to paid on or before June 25, 2017, in accordance with 15.2.1.9(B)(7)(f) NMAC and 15.2.3.8 (B)(3)(I) NMAC: Failure to pay fine in prescribed time may result in an immediate suspension.

Meraz**, having been duly notified, and appeared by telephone before the Board of Stewards on April 23, 2017, regarding a confirmed positive test for the Class III drug "Clenbuterol", in sample **NM 23690**, after it was collected from the horse "**Perrys Stamina**" which finished 1st in the 7th race, Jan. 27, 2017, at Sunland Park Race Track;
(The original lab report indicated a finding of Clenbuterol in the urine at 474 pg/ml. Split sample rights, as provided in 15.2.6.10(D) NMAC were offered and confirmed by Industrial Laboratories at 474 pg/ml).

Licensee is found in violation of:

15.2.6.9(C)(1) NMAC: Which states that "A finding by the Commission approved laboratory of a prohibited drug, chemical or other substance in a test specimen of a horse is prima facie evidence that the prohibited drug, chemical or other substance was administered to the horse and, in the case of a post-race test, was present in the horse's body while it was participating in a race.

15.2.6.9(C)(3) NMAC: There is no permissible concentration of clenbuterol that is allowed to appear in any official sample.

For this **FIRST - Class 3B medication violation** the Board of Stewards assessed **Jose E. Meraz** a penalty as follows.

1. **A 30 day suspension** of all NMRC licenses starting April 24, 2017, through May 23, 2017, inclusive. Jose E. Meraz waived his appeal rights in order to start his suspension immediately.
2. **Seven hundred and fifty (\$750.00) dollar fine to paid on or before May 23, 2017**, in accordance with 15.2.1.9(B)(7)(f) NMAC and 15.2.3.8 (B)(3)(l) NMAC: Failure to pay fine in prescribed time may result in an immediate suspension.
3. Pursuant to rules 15.2.6.9(C)(5)(c), 15.2.6.9 (C)(6), and 15.2.6.9(C)(7), the horse "**Perrys Stamina**" is placed on the Stewards list for a minimum period of 60 days (beginning **Feb 7, 2017**). 4. The horse "**Perrys Stamina**" is hereby disqualified from **FIRST PLACE** and ordered unplaced from the **7th race on Jan. 27, 2017 at Sunland Park Racetrack**, for all but pari-mutuel wagering. The purse redistribution is as follows.

Unplaced "Perrys Stamina"

A positive test for a prohibited drug or medication or other prohibited substance or the presence of permitted medication in excess of maximum allowable levels as reported by the commission approved laboratory is prima facie evidence of a violation of this rule. The Trainer is absolutely responsible regardless of the acts of third party."

15.2.3.8(B)(3)(k) NMAC: Which states in pertinent part that "Purses, prizes, awards and trophies shall be redistributed if the Stewards or Commission order a change in the official order of finish."

During said time of applicable suspension, Jose E. Meraz is hereby excluded from all areas of the grounds under the jurisdiction of the NMSRC, in accordance with 15.2.1.9 (C)(21)(a-b) NMAC, and 15.2.3.8 (B)(3)(f) NMAC. Additionally, effective upon applicable suspension dates, all horses owned or trained, or under the care of Jose E. Meraz are ineligible to be entered or start in any race in this jurisdiction, per 15.2.1.9 (C)(21)(c) NMAC.
