The NMHA staff have been extremely busy addressing the needs of the horsemen due to the effects of the pandemic. The program provided a great deal of assistance during this unprecedented time. The NMHA provided \$46,200 in direct financial assistance and an additional \$6,400 indirect financial assistance.  Stall Reimbursement Program — another financial assistance program. Where the Board of Directors of NMHA agreed to provide assistance to horsemen by reimbursing horsemen who have horses stabled at the DAA half of the cost of stall rent being charged from May 11, 2020 through June 11, 2020. For horsemen arriving after May 11, 2020 the stall rent reimbursement is being prorated. As of June 23, 2020, NMHA have received requests under this program a total of \$74,182.00.
