**Ruling:** 

Owner, Juan Esquivel Jr. having been duly notified and appeared before the Board of Stewards on February 4, 2017, regarding a lab report from UC/Davis (official testing laboratory for the NMSRC), for a confirmed positive for the prohibited compounded Class 3B drug "16-OHstanozolol" a metabolite of stanozolol detected in horse "Mister Brooks" (test sample #NM21710), who finished third place in the 8th race, on November 27, 2016, at Zia Park Racetrack in Hobbs, NM, ... "16-OHstanozolol" was confirmed in the split sample sent to Industrial Laborites on January 17, 2017.

Eric Quintana, the trainer of record for the horse "Mister Brooks", was duly notified and appeared for the hearing. This is Mr. Quintana's FIRST Class 3B medication violation in a 365 day period issued in accordance with 15.2.6.9 (L)NMAC

This penalty has aggravating circumstances which are:

1. JUAN ESQUIVEL JR admitted full responsibility during the hearing to entering horse "Mister Brooks" while the horse was still in his care and custody.

2. "16-OHstanozolol" is a compounded medication, and all compounded medications are prohibited in the state of New Mexico.

3. Mr. Juan Esquivel Jr. has prior medication volitions with similar circumstances.

For this SECOND Class 3B medication violation in a 365 day period issued in accordance with 15.2.6.9 (L)NMAC, the Board of Stewards assessed Juan Esquivel Jr. a penalty as follows.

1. A 180 day suspension of all NMRC licenses starting February 4, 2017, through August 3, 2017, inclusive.

2. 2. (\$2,500) two thousand and five hundred dollar fine to paid on or before <u>March 6, 2017</u>, in accordance with 15.2.1.9(B)(7)(f) NMAC and 15.2.3.8 (B)(3)(l) NMAC: Failure to pay fine in prescribed time may result in an immediate suspension.

3. Pursuant to rules 15.2.6.9(D)(5)(c), 15.2.6.9 (D)(6), and 15.2.6.9(D)(7), the horse "Mister Brooks" was placed on the Stewards list for a period of 60 days (beginning <u>December 9, 2016</u>). During this period, the papers are to be removed from the racing office and horse is denied entry until he passes a commission approved veterinary examination with a negative blood and urine test prior to entry.

4. The horse "<u>Mister Brooks</u>" is hereby disqualified from <u>THIRD place</u> and ordered unplaced from the <u>8th race, on November 27, 2016,</u> <u>at Zia Park Racetrack</u>, for all but pari-mutuel wagering. The purse redistribution is as follows:

Additionally, effective upon applicable suspension dates, all horses owned or trained, or under the care of Juan Esquivel Jr. are ineligible to be entered or start in any race in this jurisdiction, per 15.2.1.9 (C)(21)(c) NMAC.

Trainer Second Lifetime offense (365-day period) in any jurisdiction: A minimum 30-day suspension absent mitigating circumstances or the presence of aggravating factors could be used to impose a maximum 180-day suspension. A minimum \$1,000 absent mitigating circumstances or the presence of aggravating factors could be used to impose a maximum fine of \$2,500. Trainer Eric Quintana, having been duly notified and appeared before the Board of Stewards on February 4, 2017, regarding a lab report from UC/Davis (official testing laboratory for the NMSRC), for a confirmed positive for the prohibited compounded Class 3B drug "16-OHstanozolol" a metabolite of stanozolol detected in horse "Mister Brooks" (test sample #NM21710), who finished third place in the 8th race, on November 27, 2016, at Zia Park Racetrack in Hobbs, NM, . "16-OHstanozolol" was confirmed in the split sample sent to Industrial Laborites on January 17, 2017.

Juan Esquivel Jr., owner of record for the horse "Mister Brooks", was duly notified and appeared for the hearing. This is Mr. Esquivel's SECOND Class 3B medication violation in a 365 day period issued in accordance with 15.2.6.9 (L)NMAC

For this **FIRST Class 3B medication violation** in a 365 day period issued in accordance with 15.2.6.9 (L)NMAC, the Board of Stewards assessed Eric **Quintana** a penalty as follows.

1. A 30 day suspension of all NMRC licenses starting February 4, 2017, through March 6, 2017, inclusive.

2. (\$750) seven hundred and fifty dollar fine to paid on or before <u>March 6, 2017</u>, in accordance with 15.2.1.9(B)(7)(f) NMAC and 15.2.3.8 (B)(3)(l) NMAC: Failure to pay fine in prescribed time may result in an immediate suspension.

3. Jockey, <u>Jose Luis Enriquez</u>, having been summoned, having failed to appear or send a representative, and had his hearing held in absentia Board of Stewards <u>on February 4, 2017</u>, for careless riding during the running of the <u>2nd race on January 15, 2017</u>, while <u>aboard #7 "Kicken Durt" which resulted in his mount being</u> <u>disqualified and placed behind the 5 (the horse in which he interfered with)</u>. (Jose Luis Enriquez allowed his mount to break in, squeezing the 5 from his lane, and impeding the forward progress of the 5.)

For this violation, the Board of Stewards assessed <u>Jose Luis Enriquez</u> a suspension of 3 race days (<u>February</u> 14, 2017, February 17, 2017, and February 18, 2017). Jose Luis Enriquez is allowed to ride designated races. This ruling is in accordance with:
