Trainer/Owner <u>Jeffery Hudson</u> was duly notified and waived his right to a 10 day notice and formal hearing before the Board of Stewards on February 24, 2018, regarding an affidavit from UC/Davis (official testing laboratory for the NMRC). The affidavit was for a confirmed positive for the therapeutic drug, Phenylbutazone (class 4 penalty category C MINOR drug) found in test sample NM31509 taken from the 2nd place finisher "A Bit More Luck" following the 4th race, on February 6, 2018, at Sunland Park Racetrack in Sunland Park, NM.

The original lab report indicated a finding of Phenylbutazone at 3.83 micrograms per milliliter in the blood, which exceeds the allowable limit of 2.0 micrograms per milliliter in the blood. Split sample rights as provided in 15.2.6.10 (D) NMAC, were afforded to and declined by Jeffery Hudson.

For **Jeffery Hudson's FIRST** Class 4C MINOR medication violation (as an owner and trainer) in a 365-day period, the Board of Stewards hereby assess a penalty as follows:

- 1. A (\$300) three hundred dollar fine to be paid on or before April 4, 2018, in accordance with 15.2.3.8 (B)(3)(l) NMAC. Failure to pay fine in prescribed time may result in an immediate suspension.
- 2. The horse "A Bit More Luck", must pass a commission-approved examination before being eligible to enter.

Dexamethasone was confirmed at 59.1±3.1 pg/ml in the blood of the split sample sent to Industrial Laboratories on January 4, 2018.

Larry Nichols, Denise Nichols, and Ms. Winifred Vick (trustee Robert Vick), the owners of record for horse "Dapirate", were duly notified for a hearing on February 25, 2018. Denise Nichols, failed to appear, and had her hearing held in absentia, in accordance with 15.2.1.9(B)(4)(d)non-appearance.
