(Bore in after the start interfering with #3 causing him to check sharply and alter course.)

For this violation, the Board of Stewards assessed <u>Reyes Gomez</u> a suspension of <u>7 calendar days</u> (<u>April 17, 2019 thru April 23, 2019</u>). <u>Reyes Gomez</u> is allowed to ride designated races.

Trainer/Owner: Elliot Bachicha was duly notified and appeared by telephone before the Board of Stewards on April 16, 2019. The hearing was in regard to a certificate of analysis from Industrial Laboratories (the official testing laboratory for the NMRC) for a confirmed positive for the prohibited controlled substance (class 3 penalty B) drug "Clenbuterol" at 19 pg/ml which exceeds the authorized limit of 0pg/ml detected in the horse "My Mister Pt" (Test Sample #: E305830), who finished 2nd in the 3rd race on March 8, 2019, at Sunland Park Racetrack. Elliot Bachicha, is the owner of record for horse "My Mister Pt".

Split sample rights as provided in 15.2.6.10 (D) NMAC, were afforded to and declined by trainer.

For Elliot Bachicha's 2nd Class 3B medication violation in a 365-day period, the Board of Stewards hereby assess a penalty issued in accordance with 15.2.6.9 (B)(2) Penalty Recommendations, as follows:

- 1. A 180 day suspension of all NMRC licenses starting May 11, 2019, through November 6, 2019, inclusive. . These dates are associated with other rulings, and may become effective immediately if those rulings are amended.
- 2. A (\$2500.00) Twenty Five Hundred Dollar fine to be paid on or before May 15, 2019, in accordance with 15.2.3.8 (B)(3)(l). Failure to pay fine in prescribed time will result in immediate suspension.

Owner Jeannine L. Richardson was duly notified and failed to appear before the Board of Stewards, and had her hearing in absentia, in accordance with 15.2.1.9(B)(4)(d)non-appearance, on April 20, 2019. The hearing was in regard to a confirmed positive for the therapeutic drug Dexamethasone (class 4C major), found in test sample #E276375. The test sample was taken from the second place finisher "J J's Event" following the 6th race on July 8, 2018 at the Downs of Albuquerque.

The certificate of analysis from Industrial Laboratories (official testing laboratory for the NMRC) indicated a finding of Dexamethasone at 26.3 +/- 2.2 pg/ml in the blood, which exceeds the limit of 5.0 pg/ml per 15.2.6.9 NMAC Attachment 2

Split sample rights where afforded to the trainer and conformed at 11 +/- 2 pg/ml by TVMDL.

Bart Hone was the trainer of record for the horse "J J's Event" at the time of the violation.

In accordance with 15.2.6.9(B)(4) PENALTY RECOMMENDATIONS, this is Jeannine L. Richardson First Class 4C MAJOR medication violation in a 365-day period. The Board of Stewards hereby assess penalty as follows:

If the deadline falls on a Saturday, Sunday or legal holiday, the period is extended to include the next day that is not a Saturday, Sunday or legal holiday. The appeal must be received by noon, at the main commission offices or with the stewards who issued the ruling and must be accompanied by a fee in the amount of \$500. The fee must be in the form of cash, a cashier's check, money order or personal check."
