Trainer Ross Amestov, having waived his right to a 10 day notice and formal hearing before the Board Of Stewards on January 20, 2018, regarding an affidavit from UC/Davis (official testing laboratory for the NMSRC). The affidavit was for a confirmed positive for the therapeutic drug, Phenylbutazone (class 4 penalty category C drug) found in test sample NM 29566 taken from the winner "Tiz Valiant" following the 5th race, December 04, 2017, at Zia Park Racetrack, in Hobbs, Nm.

The affidavit indicated a finding of Phenylbutazone at 17.76 micrograms per milliliter in the blood, which exceeds the allowable limit of 2.0 micrograms per milliliter in the blood. Split sample rights as provided in 15.2.6.10 (D) NMAC, were afforded to and declined by Ross Amestoy.

Mike Abraham, Leslie Amestoy, and Pierre J. Amestoy Jr., the owners of record for horse "Tiz Valiant", were duly notified and failed to appear for this hearing. This is their FIRST Class 4C medication violation in a 365-day period, in accordance with 15.2.6.9(B)(4) PENALTY RECOMMENDATIONS.

For Ross Amestoy's FIRST Class 4C medication violation in a 365-day period, the Board of Stewards hereby assess a (\$1,000) one thousand dollar fine to be paid on or before January 23, 2018, in accordance with 15.2.3.8 (B)(3)(l) NMAC. Failure to pay fine in prescribed time may result in an immediate suspension

Exercise Person, KALIE SUSAN HUDSON, was summarily suspended on <u>January 26, 2018</u>, and waived <u>her</u> rights to a formal disciplinary hearing before the Board of Stewards on <u>February 3, 2018</u>. <u>KALIE SUSAN HUDSON</u> tested positive for <u>amphetamine and methamphetamine</u> during a drug screening on <u>January 26, 2018</u>.

The Board of Stewards hereby suspend all NMRC licenses belonging to <u>KALIE SUSAN HUDSON</u> for <u>60 days</u>, <u>January 26</u>, <u>2018</u>, <u>through March 26</u>, <u>2018</u>, <u>inclusive</u> (retroactive from the summary suspension issued on <u>January 26</u>, <u>2018</u>). <u>30 days will be deferred upon immediate enrollment in Chaplain Donald Stover's "Turning Point Program" (16.47.1.18(C)).</u> After 30 days has been served, <u>KALIE SUSAN HUDSON</u> must submit a negative sample and is given probationary status. Furthermore, <u>KALIE SUSAN HUDSON</u> may be tested at the request of the stewards at any time. Failure to attend "The Turning Point Program" will result <u>KALIE SUSAN HUDSON</u>'s immediate suspension to serve the remainder of the 60 days.

<u>Per 15.2.1.9 (C)(21)(a-b) NMAC</u>, While under suspension, <u>KALIE SUSAN HUDSON</u> is excluded from all areas of the grounds under the jurisdiction of the NMRC.
