Owner Aimee M. Rosa having been duly notified and appeared before the Board Of Stewards on April 21, 2019, regarding a lab report from Industrial Laboratories (The official testing laboratory for the NMRC), for a confirmed positive for the drugs, Ketoprofen at 223 +/- 0.3 ng/ml (a class 4C-Major penalty drug) and Furosemide at 712 +/- 10 ng/ml in blood, (a class 4C-Minor penalty drug) found in test sample E276849 taken from the last place finisher "Snowbound Jones" following the 5th race, on August 10, 2018, at the Downs at Albuquerque Race Track.

The allowable limit for Ketoprofen is 2 ng/ml in the blood. The allowable limit of Furosemide is 100 ng/ml in blood. (15.2.6.9 Attachment 2).

Split sample rights as provided in 15.2.6.10 (D) NMAC, were afforded to trainer, and confirmed by Analytical Toxicology Lab for Ketoprofen at 136 ±/- 5 ng/ml in blood and Furosemide at 727 ±/- 62 ng/ml.

Bart Hone was the trainer of record for the horse "Snowbound Jones" at the time of the violation.

In accordance with 15.2.6.9(B)(4) PENALTY RECOMMENDATIONS, this is Aimee M. Rosa's First Class 4C MAJOR medication violation in a 365-day period. The Board of Stewards hereby assess penalty as follows:

1. The horse "Snowbound Jones" is hereby disqualified from 8th place and ordered unplaced from the 5th race on August 10, 2018 at the Downs of Albuquerque for all but pari-mutuel wagering.

2. The horse Snowbound Jones must pass a commission-approved examination before being eligible to run.

Jockey Jansen Melancon having been duly notified and having appeared before the Board of Stewards on April 23, 2019, for having failed to be excused from and subsequent failure to honor his riding engagement on the #10 horse, Freckled in the fourth race on Sunday, April 21, 2019, at Sunland Park Racetrack.

The Board of Stewards hereby assesses **Jansen Melancon a** penalty in the amount of **two hundred** dollars (\$200.00). The fine is to be paid on or before May 23, 2019, in accordance with 15.2.3.8(B) (3) (1) NMAC. Failure to pay the fine within the time prescribed may result in immediate suspension.

(Bore in down the backstretch impeding #3 & #4 causing the #3 to check sharply, The #3 was vanned off the track after the running of this race.)

Trainer Martin Orona Sr. was duly notified and waived his right to a hearing before the Board of Stewards, and was represented by his attorney Daniel Marquez, on April 27, 2019. The hearing was in regard to a confirmed positive for the therapeutic drug Flunixin (class 4C major), found in test sample #E291091. The test sample was taken from the horse, "Ave Fenix", following the 4th race on December 1, 2018 at Zia Park Racetrack.

The certificate of analysis from <u>Industrial Laboratories (official testing laboratory for the NMRC)</u> indicated a finding of <u>Flunixin at 180 +/- 3 ng/ml in the blood, which exceeds 100 ng/ml making it a 4C major.</u> Split sample rights as provided in <u>15.2.6.10 (D) NMAC</u>, were afforded to and declined by the trainer.

Miguel Galindo was the owner of record at the time of the incident for the horse "Ave Fenix".

In accordance with 15.2.6.9(B)(4) PENALTY RECOMMENDATIONS, this is <u>trainer Martin Orona Sr's Second Class 4C MAJOR medication violation in a 365-day period.</u> The Board of Stewards hereby assess penalty as follows:

- 1. A (\$1,500) one thousand five hundred dollar fine to paid on or before May 27, 2019, in accordance with 15.2.3.8 (B)(3)(I) NMAC. Failure to pay the fine in the prescribed time shall result in an immediate suspension.
- 2. <u>A 15 day suspension</u> of all NMRC licenses starting April 29, 2019, through May 13, 2019, inclusive.
