Trainer, Justin Evans having been duly notified and waived his right to a 10 day notice and a hearing via telephone before the Board of Stewards on **October 1, 2019**, for missing Lasix for entry, "**Indian Jack**", which resulted in a late scratch and mutuel refund in the **6th race on September 30th, 2019, at Zia Park Racetrack**.

For this violation, the Board of Stewards assessed **Justin Evans** a fine in the amount of **two hundred dollars, (\$200.00)**. The fine is to be paid on or before **November 1, 2019**, in accordance with 15.2.3.8 (B)(3)(8) NMAC. Failure to pay the fine within the time prescribed may result in immediate suspension

15.2.6.9(D) (2) USE OF FUROSEMIDE IN DETENTION BARN The use of furosemide shall be permitted under the following circumstances on association grounds where a detention barn is utilized: furosemide shall be administered by the official veterinarian, the racing veterinarian, or practicing veterinarian no less than four hours prior to post in which the horse is entered. A horse qualified for furosemide administration must be brought to the detention barn one hour prior to the fourhour administration requirement specified above. After treatment, the horse shall be required by the commission to remain in the detention barn in the care, custody and control of its trainer or the trainer's designated representative under association or commission security supervision until called to the saddling paddock.

15.2.6.9(D) (3) USE OF FUROSEMIDE ON ASSOCIATION GROUNDS The use of furosemide shall be permitted under the following circumstances on association grounds where a detention barn is not utilized: furosemide shall be administered by the official veterinarian, the racing veterinarian, or practicing veterinarian no less than four hours prior to post in which a horse is entered; the horse must be logged in at the stable gate with time and location no less than one hour prior to administration; the furosemide dosage administered shall not exceed 500 milligrams nor be less than 150 milligrams; the trainer of the treated horse shall cause to be delivered to the official veterinarian or their designee no later than one hour prior to post time for the race for which the horse is entered the following information under oath on a form provided by the commission: the racetrack name, the date and time the furosemide was administered to the entered horse; the dosage amount of furosemide administered to the entered horse; the printed name and signature of the attending licensed veterinarian who administered the furosemide
