The third-party track inspection of Ruidoso Downs was conducted by Kevin Seymour, the highly recommended trackman from Oaklawn Park in Hot Springs, AR. He observed, looked over the equipment used on the track and took samples. One issue is getting enough water on this track. Mr. Seymour gave his initial impressions of his observations that day. However, a written report of his soil analysis and all other findings will be provided within 10 days of this inspection.
