Trainer: Javier Roman, (currently under summary suspension) was duly notified and appeared by telephone before the Board of Stewards on July 17, 2021. The hearing was in regard to the confirmed positive of the Drug Class 3 Penalty Class A (Quarter Horses), Clenbuterol a Controlled Substance, found in test sample E436415 taken from the 2nd place finisher, "Jr Little Regard", in the 1st race on May 15, 2021, at Sunray Park Racetrack.

Split sample rights as provided per 15.2.6.10 (D) NMAC, were afforded to the trainer and declined.

Francisco Roman Sr, is the owner of record for the horse "Jr Little Regard".

Aggravating Factor: Clenbuterol is a Zero tolerance, Controlled Substance drug in New Mexico.

Aggravating Factor: Potential of the drug to influence a horse's performance.

Aggravating Factor: Past record of medication violations.

For Javier Roman's FIRST Class 3A medication violation in a LIFETIME the Board of Stewards hereby assess a penalty, issued in accordance with 15.2.6.9 (B)(1) Penalty Recommendations, as follows:

- 1. A 1 ½ year suspension of all NMRC licenses (retroactive from summary suspension) June 16, 2021, through December 16, 2022, inclusive,
- 2. A (15,000.00) Fifteen thousand dollar fine to paid on or before August 18, 2021, in accordance with 15.2.3.8 (B)(3)(k). Failure to pay the fine in the prescribed time shall result in an immediate suspension.
- 3. In addition, because Mr. Javier Roman has accumulated "0" points prior to this ruling and "6" points in connection with this ruling for a current total of 6"", under the multiple medication violation point system,

In accordance with 15.2.1.9 (C)(21), Javier Roman is hereby excluded from all areas of the grounds under the jurisdiction of the NMRC. Additionally, effective upon applicable suspension dates, all horses owned, trained, or under the care of Javier Roman are ineligible to be entered or start in any race in this jurisdiction, per 15.2.1.9 (C)(21)(c). All transfers and sales of horses trained, owned, or in the care and custody of Beatriz Javier Roman must be done in accordance with 15.2.6.9A(12)(a)(b) Medication and Prohibited Substances, 16.47.1.10 (D)(5)Assistant Trainers and 15.2.1.9(B)(8)(b) DUE PROCESS AND DISCIPLINARY ACTION.

Exercise Person/ Groom: Dosi R. Alvarez currently under summarily suspended, effective July 10, 2021, waived his 10 day notice of hearing and requested a disciplinary hearing on July 18, 2021 at 9:30 a.m in the offices of the Board of Stewards at Ruidoso Downs Racetrack regarding his possession of marijuana, mushrooms and other drug paraphernalia as well as a loaded 9 mm firearm in his truck in the barn area on July 10, 2021.

For this violation, after considering mitigating circumstances and the clean record of Dosi R. Alvarez, the Board of Stewards issue the following penalty:

1. A suspension of any/all New Mexico Racing Commission licenses, effective July 10, 2021 through October 9, 2021 inclusive,

2. A (\$750.00) seven hundred and fifty dollar fine The fine is to paid on or before August 19,2021 in accordance with 15.2.3.8(B)(3)(I) NMAC. Failure to pay the fine within the time prescribed may result in immediate suspension.

In accordance with 15.2.1.9 (C)(21) Exclusion. Dosi R. Alvarez is hereby excluded from all areas of the grounds under the jurisdiction of the NMSRC.

Licensee is found to be in violation of: and in accordance with: 15.2.6.8(H)(1) Medical Labeling No person on association grounds where horses are lodged or kept, excluding veterinarians licensed by the commission, shall have in or upon association grounds which that person occupies or has the right to occupy, or in that person's personal property or effect or vehicle in that person's care, custody or control, a drug, medication, chemical, foreign substance or other substance that is prohibited in a horse on a race day unless the product is labeled in accordance with

15.2.6.8(K)(1) Contraband No person on association grounds where horses are lodged or kept, excluding licensed veterinarians, shall have in that person's care, custody or control, a drug, medication, chemical, foreign substance or 15.2.6 NMAC 12 other substance that is prohibited in a horse on a race day unless the product is labeled in accordance with Subsection H of 15.2.6.9 NMAC. This restriction includes, but is not limited to, locations on the association grounds where that person occupies, in that person's personal property, effects or vehicle
