It is with great pleasure that the New Mexico Racing Commission (NMRC) provide you with the following report of the 2019/2020 racing season/annual report pursuant to 60-1-3(f). This report covers the 4 race meets that were conducted in the State of New Mexico.

The 2019/2020 racing season saw the New Mexico horse racing industry traverse the difficulties of the global pandemic. Due to closures of racing and gaming facilities on March 16, 2020, the New Mexico racing season was modified on multiple occasions in order to adhere to Department of Health orders. Sunland Park closed its doors 21 days shy of its scheduled closing day. The Sun-Ray Park race meet along with the New Mexico State Fair meet were cancelled in their entirety. Subsequently, the Downs at Albuquerque and Zia Park meets were shortened as well.

In its resiliency, the horse racing industry, by way of leadership from the New Mexico Racing Commission, got back on track for the 2020 Ruidoso Downs race meet. Purse money was mobilized from certain racetracks to others in order to jump start the industry to finish out the race season.

All numbers and statistics pertaining to the 2019/2020 race season will show significant declines as a result of the pandemic.

In closing, the New Mexico Racing Commission assures industry stakeholders and the public in general that it is committed to focusing on navigating through the pandemic with the best interest of horse racing being first and foremost. Our focus will be on maneuvering out of the pandemic and implement change that will nurture the sustainability of the industry for years to come.

As always, the New Mexico Racing Commission staff considers it and honor and privilege to serve the people of the great state of New Mexico. Thank you for the opportunity.

# NMRC MISSION AND HISTORY

#### MISSION STATEMENT

To provide regulation in an equitable manner to New Mexico's pari-mutuel horse racing industry. To protect the interest of wagering patrons and the State of New Mexico in a manner which promotes a climate of economic prosperity for horsemen, horse owners, and racetrack management.

#### **HISTORY OF THE COMISSION**

The Horse Racing Act (HRA) was enacted in 1938, allowing horse racing and pari-mutuel wagering in New Mexico. The Racing Commission oversees compliance with the HRA.

The statute authorizes the Racing Commission to enforce and administer the statutes by allowing for the creation and enforcement of rules and regulations pertaining to horse racing.

The Racing Commission is authorized under the authority of 60-1A-1 through 60-1A-30, NMSA 1978. The statute mandates the agency to regulate and enforce the statutes, rules, and regulations of the horseracing industry. The statute authorizes a five-member commission appointed by the Governor and approved by the Senate. The current FTE is 23.8.

By statutory authority, the Racing Commission must closely work with the horse racing industry to ensure the integrity of the industry. Patrons at the racetracks rely on the Racing Commission so they may confidently place wagers on horses in races conducted within the state.

#### THE RACING COMMISSIONS'S WORK AND ACTIVITIES INCLUDES THE FOLLOWING:

- Licensing of all racing participants
- Oversight and judgement of races and racetrack operations
- Testing of selected horses for drug detection
- •Investigation and enforcement of rule and regulation infractions
- •Testing or pari-mutuel pay-outs
- Oversight of racetrack financial obligations
- •Oversight of racetrack's capability and viability to operate a race meet
- Promote and support the economic and viability of the horseracing industry within the state


#### JOHN BUFFINGTON


Trejo's main focus for the New Mexico horse racing industry is the wellbeing of the racehorse as he says, "They are the centerpiece of the industry."




All American Futurity Day at Ruidoso Downs Race Track and Casino

# NMRC DRUG TESTING PROGRAM

The New Mexico Racing Commission continues to reinforce the cornerstone of its regulation by way of a renowned drug testing program for horses. The agency certainly made its best effort to keep its focus on integrity despite a minimal amount of race days and the dissipation of funds to conduct drug testing because of the global pandemic. The number of samples analyzed decreased over 53% in 2020, when compared to 2019. In 2019, a total of 10,565 post race tests were analyzed compared to 4,949 in 2020. The agency's percentage of violations in post-race testing was .87% in 2020, .98% in 2019, down from 3.5% in 2017, a 75% decrease in 4 years. In 2019, the NMRC ranked 3rd in the nation in out of competition samples analyzed. The numbers remained strong, despite the pandemic, as the agency continues to focus on it's out of competition testing program. In total, the agency analyzed 754 out of competition samples with a violation rate of 7.3% in hair samples and 0% in blood samples. In comparison, in 2019, the NMRC had over 819 out of competition samples analyzed with a positivity rate of 7.3% in hair and 2.1% in blood.

It is a testament to his forward thinking which he labeled "radical".
