RE: 2022-DAA-44 - Ruling Final Outcome

Trainer: Pedro Gomez appeared for his Summary Suspension hearing having been duly notified and waived his right to a 10-day notice and disciplinary hearing before the Downs at Albuquerque Board of Stewards on September 9, 2022, regarding a lab report from Industrial Laboratories (The official testing laboratory for the NMRC). Clenbuterol (class 3 penalty A drug) confirmed in the urine in test sample E465106 taken from the 3rd place finisher "Deltas Harley Comet" following the 4th race on August 14th, 2022, at the Downs at Albuquerque Racetrack.

Split sample rights as provided in 15.2.6.10 (D)(2) NMAC, were afforded to trainer however, no split sample was requested within the required 48-hours.

Daniel Balderrama (Balderrama Racing, LLC) is the owner of record for the horse "Deltas Harley Comet" and was not represented by the Trainer.

Aggravating Factor(s):

- Clenbuterol is a Zero tolerance drug in New Mexico.
- No evidence was presented to disprove the findings of the racing commission.
- 3rd Medication Violation Lifetime, 2nd Clenbuterol

For **Pedro Gomez's** First-Class A medication violation in a 365 Days the Board of Stewards hereby assess a penalty, issued in accordance with 15.2.6.9 (B)(1) Penalty Recommendations, as follows:

- 1. A 5-year suspension of all NMRC licenses (retroactive from summary suspension) September 2nd, 2022, through November 2, 2027, inclusive.
- 2. A Fifty-Thousand-dollar (\$50,000.00) fine to be paid on or before September 29, 2022, in accordance with 15.2.1.9 (B)(7)(f). Failure to pay the fine in the prescribed time shall result in an immediate suspension.

In addition, Pedro Gomez has accumulated "0.5" points prior to this ruling and "6" point in connection with this ruling for a current total of "6.5" points under the multiple medication violation point system. Under the multiple medication violation point system, Pedro Gomez is subject to an additional penalty of 60 days pursuant to section 15.2.6.9 (O)(7) of NMAC.

In accordance with 15.2.1.9 (C)(21), **Pedro Gomez** is hereby excluded from all areas of the grounds under the jurisdiction of the NMRC. Additionally, effective upon applicable suspension dates, all horses owned, trained, or under the care of **Pedro Gomez** are ineligible to be entered or start in any race in this jurisdiction, per 15.2.1.9 (C)(21)(e). All transfers and sales of horses trained, owned, or in the care and custody of **Pedro Gomez** must be done in accordance with 15.2.6.9A(12)(a)(b) and approved by the Stewards.

The appeal must be received by noon, at the main commission offices or with the stewards who issued the ruling and must be accompanied by a fee in the amount of \$400.
