RE: 2022-ZIA-2 - Ruling Final Outcome

Trainer, Juan Carlos Gonzalez having been duly notified and appeared Via Teams before Zia Park Racetrack Board of Stewards (3901 W Millen Dr. Hobbs, NM 88240). A formal hearing was held on Monday, November 21, 2022, regarding a lab report from Industrial Laboratories (the Official testing laboratory for the NMRC) for a confirmed positive for the drug Clenbuterol (Class 3 penalty A) found in the blood for test sample E556171, obtained from the horse "Restrictions" finished 1st place in the (La Fiesta Futurity) on September 25, 2022, at the Downs at Albuquerque Racetrack.

Aggravating Factors: Failure to guard.

Mitigating Factors: First medication violation in 365 days.

Split Sample rights were afforded to the trainer. Split Sample E556171 was submitted to TVMDL at the request of the trainer and was confirmed positive for Clenbuterol.

Juan Carlos Gonzalez is the trainer of record for "Restrictions".

After hearing the facts of the case and testimony, and considering all Mitigating and Aggravating factors the Zia Park Board of Stewards determined the following

- 1. Mr. Juan Carlos Gonzalez is hereby fined \$10,000.00 (Ten Thousand). Fine to be paid on or before December 21, 2022, in accordance with 15.2.1.9 (B)(7)(f). Failure to pay the fine in the prescribed time shall result in an immediate suspension.
- 2. A suspension of one year. The term of this suspension will start retroactive from summary suspension dated October 7, 2022, through October 7, 2023.
- 3. In addition, Juan Carlos Gonzalez had accumulated "0" points prior to this ruling and "6" points in connection with this ruling for a current total of "6"- points, under the multiple medication violation point system. 45 additional days given. October 7th, 2023, thru November 21,2023.

All transfers and sales of horses trained, owned, or in the care and custody of Juan Carlos Gonzalez must be done in accordance with 15.2.6.9A(12)(a)(b) Medication and Prohibited Substances.
