RE: 2023-SUN-65 - Ruling Final Outcome Disciplinary Hearing 05/12/2023

Trainer Raul Vega, (currently under summary suspension) having been duly notified and appeared before the Board of Stewards on May 12, 2023, for the condition of his horse entered in an official race at Sunland Park Racetrack. The Horse "Cause for Love Too" appeared in the paddock on March 21st, 2023, for the 2nd race with open wounds, signs of being under weight, and unfit to run per the track veterinarian. The horse was scratched by the track Vet Mike Perrone due to the condition of the horse.

For this violation, the Board of Stewards hereby issues a penalty as follows:

- 1. A suspension of minimum of 5 years (March 24, 2023, thru March 24, 2028), on or after that time, Mr. Vega will be eligible to reapply for his Trainer License
- 2. Mr. Vega must go before the Commission for approval to be reinstated
- 3. Must retake the NMRC Trainers Test and Pass before being reinstated
- 4. A \$10,000 Fine which must be paid on or before June 11, 2023.

During said time of applicable suspension Raul Vega is hereby excluded from all areas of the grounds under the jurisdiction of the NMRC 15.2.1.9 (C) (21) (a-b) Exclusion.

Licensee is found in violation of and this ruling is written in accordance with:

15.2.6.11 TRAINER RESPONSIBILITY: The purpose of this subsection is to identify responsibilities of the trainer that pertain specifically to the health and wellbeing of horses in their care. A. The trainer is responsible for the condition of horses entered in an official workout or race and is responsible for the presence of any prohibited drug, medication or other substance, including permitted medication in excess of the maximum allowable level, in such horses. A positive test for a prohibited drug, medication or substance, including permitted medication in excess of the maximum allowable level, as reported by a commission approved laboratory, is prima facie evidence of a violation of this rule. In the absence of substantial evidence to the contrary, the trainer is responsible. E. Additionally, with respect to horses in their care or custody, the trainer is responsible for: (1) the proper identity, custody, care, health, condition and safety of horses;16.47.1.8 GENERAL PROVISIONS:L. Grounds for disciplinary measures for a licensee, and refusal, denial, suspension, or revocation of a license:(o) has engaged in conduct unbecoming or detrimental to the best interests of racing. U. Protection of horses:(2) licensee or other person under the jurisdiction of the commission shall subject or permit any animal under their control, custody or supervision to be subjected to or to incur any form of cruelty, mistreatment, neglect or abuse or abandon, injure, maim or kill or administer any noxious substance to or deprive any animal of necessary care or sustenance, shelter or veterinary care.16.47.1.10 TRAINERS: B. The stewards shall have authority to charge any licensee for a violation of these rules, to conduct hearings and to impose disciplinary action in accordance
