RE: 2023-SRP-32 - Ruling Final Outcome

Clocker/Test Barn Assistant Denise Hamling having appeared and waive her summary suspension10day notice and disciplinary hearing before the Sunray Park Board of Stewards on May 5, 2023, On the matter of a positive random drug test conducted on Sunday April 30, 2023.

The Board of Stewards hereby assesses a penalty as follows:

- 1. A six-month (6) month suspension retroactive to the date of the summary suspension April 30, 2023, through October 30, 2023, with potential of reevaluation at the end of 3 months (July 30th, 2023). If re-instate prior to October 30th, 2023, the remainder of the suspension will be on probationary basis. During the Probationary Time any further positive drug tests will result in a suspension of licensees' license (See requirements below.)
- 2. Must pass a drug test.
- 3. Agree to any further testing or after care required by the New Mexico Racing Commission.
- 4. After further review Denise Hamling will be required to attend a 30-day program and be cleared by a medical review officer that is approved by the state (this is required prior to review prior to reinstatement).

In accordance with 15.2.1.9 (C)(21), Clocker/Test Barn Assistant Denise Hamling is hereby excluded from all areas of the grounds under the jurisdiction of the NMRC.

Licensee is found in violation and this ruling is written in accordance with:

16.47.1.17 (A)(1) TESTING PROCEDURES At its discretion, the commission may conduct random or episodic random drug testing, as well as testing based on reasonable suspicion, in order to ensure safety on the racetrack.

16.47.1.17 (A)(2) TESTING PROCEDURES When conducted, random drug testing shall apply, equally, to all licensees who are, at the time of the random testing, exercising the privileges of their license in such ways as may affect the outcome of a race or diminish the conditions of safety or decorum required in restricted areas.
