Jockey, Jose Lopez Sainz is summarily suspended effective immediately, May 24th, 2023, pending the outcome of his summary suspension hearing scheduled for Friday, June 2, 2023, at 8:30 a.m. in the office of the Board of Stewards at Ruidoso Downs Racetrack (26225 Us Highway 70, Ruidoso Downs, New Mexico.88346), per 15.2.1.9 (B)(3)(b) Summary Suspension. The summary suspension is regarding an incident on May 22,2023, allegeding you were seen striking the horse Champagne Dynasty in the head several times, which is deemed animal cruelty pursuant to NMAC 16.47.1.8(U) (2).

NMAC 16.47.1.8 (L)(1)(i) Grounds for disciplinary measures for a licensee, and refusal, denial, suspension, or revocation of a license: (1) The commission may refuse to issue a license to an applicant, or may suspend or revoke a license issued, or order disciplinary measures, if the applicant:

(i) is a person whose conduct or reputation may adversely reflect on the honesty and integrity of horse racing or interfere with the orderly conduct of a race meeting; interfering with the orderly conduct of a race meeting shall include, but is not limited to, disruptive or intemperate behavior or behavior which exposes others to danger anywhere on the racetrack grounds; the fact that the race meet was not actually interrupted is not a defense to the imposition of discipline under this rule;

been summarily suspended is entitled to a hearing on the summary suspension not later than the 10th day after the license was summarily suspended. The licensee

may waive their right to a hearing on the summary suspension within the 10-day limit. (c) The stewards shall conduct a hearing on the summary suspension in the same

manner as other disciplinary hearings. At a hearing on a summary suspension, the sole issue is whether the licensee's license should remain suspended pending a final disciplinary hearing and ruling.

Jockey Juan Pulido, having been summoned and appeared before the Board of Stewards on May 29,2023, for excessive use of whip, while aboard "Acowboywalksintoabar" in the 13th Race May 27, 2023, at Ruidoso Downs, is found to be in violation of Commission rules.

For this violation, the Board of Stewards assessed Jockey Juan Pulido, a fine in the amount of Five-Hundred Dollars. (\$500.00). This fine is to be paid on or before June 28, 2023, in accordance with 15.2.3.8 (B)(3)(1) . Failure to pay the fine within the time prescribed shall result in immediate suspension.

Licensee is found to be in violation of:

15.2.5.13(E)(6)(A) Use of riding crops. Although the use of a riding crop is not required, any jockey who uses a riding crop during a race shall do so only in a manner consistent with exerting his or her best efforts to win.

15.2.5.13(E)(6)(e) Use of riding crops. Indiscriminate use of the whip is prohibited including whipping a horse: on the head, flanks or on any other part of its body other than the shoulders or hind quarters except when necessary to control a horse; during the post parade or after the finish of the race except when necessary to control the horse; excessively or brutally causing welts or breaks in the skin; when the horse is clearly out of the race or has obtained its maximum placing; persistently even though the horse is showing no response under the riding crop; or striking another rider or horse.

Jockey Adrian Ramos, having been summoned and appeared before the Board of Stewards on May 29,2023, for excessive use of whip, while aboard "Ezee Monee" in the 9th Race May 28, 2023, at Ruidoso Downs, is found to be in violation of Commission rules.

For this violation, the Board of Stewards assessed Jockey Adrian Ramos, a fine in the amount of Five-Hundred Dollars. (\$500.00). This fine is to be paid on or before June 28, 2023, in accordance with 15.2.3.8 (B)(3)(1) . Failure to pay the fine within the time prescribed shall result in immediate suspension.

Licensee is found to be in violation of:

15.2.5.13(E)(6)(A) Use of riding crops. Although the use of a riding crop is not required, any jockey who uses a riding crop during a race shall do so only in a manner consistent with exerting his or her best efforts to win.
