RE: 2023-DAA-56 - Ruling Final Outcome

Trainer Arnulfo Ascencio Jr having been duly notified and having failed appear, had his hearing held in absentia, in accordance with 15.2.1.9(B)(4)(d) non-appearance before Sunland Park Racetrack Board of Stewards (1200 Futurity Drive, Sunland Park NM 88063) on January 17, 2024 for a formal hearing, regarding a lab report from Industrial Laboratories (the Official testing laboratory for the NMRC) for a confirmed positive for the drug Clenbuterol (Class 3 penalty A) found in the blood for test sample E625947, obtained from the horse "Work Ethic" who finished 2nd place in the 4th race on September 27, 2023, at the Downs at Albuquerque Racetrack.

Aggravating Factors: Failure to guard.

Mitigating Factors: First medication violation in 365 days.

Split Sample rights were afforded to the trainer. Split Sample E625947 was submitted to UC Davis at the request of the trainer and was confirmed positive for Clenbuterol.

Arnulfo Ascencio Jr is the trainer of record for "Work Ethic".

After hearing the facts of the case and testimony, and considering all Mitigating and Aggravating factors the Sunland Park Board of Stewards determined the following:

1) Mr. Arnulfo Ascencio Jr is hereby fined \$10,000.00 (Ten Thousand). Fine to be paid on or before February 28, 2024, in accordance with 15.2.1.9 (B)(7)(f). Failure to pay the fine in the prescribed time shall result in an immediate suspension.

2) A suspension of one (1) year. The term of this suspension will start retroactive from summary suspension dated October 18, 2023, through October 18, 2024.

3) In addition, Arnulfo Ascencio Jr had accumulated "0" points prior to this ruling and "6" points in connection with this ruling for a current total of "6"- points, under the multiple medication violation point system.

4) Mr. Arnulfo Ascencio Jr must take a written trainers test once he has served his penalty.

(d) The stewards may determine that a horse shall be unplaced for the purpose of purse distribution and trial qualification.

In accordance with 15.2.1.9 (C)(21), Arnulfo Ascencio Jr will be excluded from all areas and grounds under the jurisdiction of the NMRC. Additionally, effective upon applicable suspension dates, all horses owned, trained, or under the care of Arnulfo Ascencio Jr are ineligible to be entered or start in any race in this jurisdiction, per 15.2.1.9 (C)(21)(c). All transfers and sales of horses trained, owned, or in the care and custody of Arnulfo Ascencio Jr must be done in accordance with 15.2.6.9A(12)(a)(b) Medication and Prohibited Substances.

The fee must be in the form of a cashier's check or a money order.
