(Seven Hundred Fifty Dollars) Pursuant to 15.2.3.8: B.(k) All fines imposed by the stewards shall be paid to the commission within 30 days after the ruling is issued, unless otherwise ordered. This fine is to be paid on or before May 7, 2024, in accordance with 15.2.3.8 (B)(3)(e)(i)(k). Failure to pay the fine in the prescribed time shall result in an immediate suspension.
