Veterinarian Tony Pickard having been duly notified and having appeared for his hearing at 9:15 a.m. on May 9, 2024, at Sunray Park in the offices of the Board of Stewards (39 Road 5568 Farmington, NM 87401 regarding a citation he received for administering Lasix to the horse "New Mexico Jeremy" which necessitated a late scratch from race 12 on April 28, 2024. (Not a registered Lasix user) NMAC 15.2.6.8 (B)(7) Treatment Restrictions; Veterinarians shall not have contact with an entered horse on race day except for the administration of furosemide under the guidelines set forth in Subsection D of 15.2.6.9 NMAC unless approved by the official veterinarian or in an emergency situation. Should an emergency occur during evening hours, the veterinarian shall notify the official veterinarian as soon as possible the following morning

For this rule violation, the Sunray Park Board of Stewards assess Veterinarian Tony Pickard a penalty in the amount of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00).
