Jockey Daniel Amaya, having been summoned and having Rodolfo Guerra represent him in the film review before the Board of Stewards on October 6, 2024, for excessive use of whip, while aboard "Rc Corona King" in the 8th Race October 5,2024 at Sunland Park Racetrack, is found to be in violation of Commission rules.

For this violation (3rd offense of 2024), the Board of Stewards assessed Jockey Daniel Amaya a 7(seven)day. Starting October 14,2024 through October 20,2024.

Indiscriminate use of the whip is prohibited including whipping a horse: on the head, flanks or on any other part of its body other than the shoulders or hind quarters except when necessary to control a horse; during the post parade or after the finish of the race except when necessary to control the horse; excessively or brutally causing welts or breaks in the skin; when the horse is clearly out of the race or has obtained its maximum placing; persistently even though the horse is showing no response under the riding crop; or striking another rider or horse.

Jockey, Esgar Ramirez, having been properly summoned and having appeared before The Down at Albuquerque Board of Stewards, on October 9, 2024, for careless riding during the running of the 2nd race on October 6, 2024, at The Downs at Albuquerque Racetrack while aboard # 3 "Cowboy On the Tree" who veered out sharply impeding #5 & #6 and costing both horses an opportunity of a better placing thus resulting in the disqualification of his mount from 3rd to 7th place.

For this violation, the Board of Stewards issued the following penalty:

A 7-calendar day suspension, beginning on October 16, 2024, through October 22, 2024. Mr. Esgar Ramirez may ride designated races.
