		 Executive Director Trejo also gave kudos to NM Racing Commission State Investigator Garcia for achieving national recognition for a paper trainer case she just completed. Executive Director Trejo reported that the fee being implemented begins tomorrow. DFA has made it clear to the NMRC that state budget division shall monitor revenue received by agencies from sources other than any other agency whose revenue from such sources is not meeting projections. This falls right in line with the equine test fund. They will begin taking money from our operating budget. The drug testing fee will be \$20 per horse per start. We hated doing this, but it is out of necessity. Vice-Chairman Buffington reiterated that this move was necessary due to all the simulcast signals pulled from NM. Executive Director Trejo reported opening weekend at SunRay Park did a great job getting ready to being their meet. The inspection of the track was completed the other day. There is still work to be done because of the flooding they have experienced last year as well. Chairman Smith also congratulated the two tracks for such low catastrophic rates this year.
