Executive Director Trejo reported that for the West Texas Futurity, there were 14 positives reported by the lab (13 Albuterol and 1 clenbuterol). He says he is being told that horses are showing up with wet hair that smells like bleach. The cheating MUST stop! Executive Director Trejo discussed the very significant Federal Ruling just received. It was in favor of the racetracks. The order says there is not one horsemen's group. There can be a different horsemen's group for each race meet. Executive Director Trejo also reported that Senate Bill 323 was put on hold. This bill is regarding increasing the number of live race dates by mandating that the tracks simulcast New Mexico race signals every day in order to operate slot machines. Mary Barber presented the Race-A-Day Report for Sunland Park through Sunday, March 9, 2025, stating it ran 139 NM Bred Races in 38 days through Sunday, March 9, 2025.
