Jockey Christian Cardenas having been duly notified and having his agent Victor Escobar represent him before the SunRay Park Board of Stewards on April 26th, 2025, for excessive use of whip, while aboard #4 "Jaelys Jewel" in the 6th Race on April 25th, 2025, at SunRay Park.

For this violation, the Board of Stewards issued the following:

Christian Luis Cardenas (2nd offense of 2025) a fine in the amount of One Thousand Dollars. (\$1,000.00). This fine is to be paid on or before June 1, 2025, in accordance with NMAC 15.2.1.9 (A)(7)(f). Failure to pay the fine in the prescribed time shall result in an immediate suspension.

Licensee is found to be in violation of NMAC:

15.2.5.13 E. (7)(a) Use of riding crops. Although the use of a riding crop is not required, any jockey who uses a riding crop during a race shall do so only in a manner consistent with exerting his or her best efforts to win.

15.2.5.13 E. (7)(e) The riding crop shall only be used for safety, correction and encouragement.

15.2.5.13 E. (8) Use of riding crops. Indiscriminate use of the whip is prohibited including whipping a horse: on the head, flanks or on any other part of its body other than the shoulders or hind quarters except when necessary to control a horse; during the post parade or after the finish of the race except when necessary to control the horse; excessively or brutally causing welts or breaks in the skin; when the horse is clearly out of the race or has obtained its maximum placing; persistently even though the horse is showing no response under the riding crop; or striking another rider or horse.

15.2.5.13 (E)(9)(a)(b) Excessive use of the crop includes: (a) Riders cannot use the riding crop more than three times in succession during a race, excluding showing or waiving the (b) Riders cannot use the crop more than three times in succession without giving the horse a chance to respond before using the crop again.

Jockey Kevin Enriquez Arenivas having been duly notified appeared before the SunRay Park Board of Stewards on May 16th, 2025, for excessive use of whip, while aboard #5 "Miss Classy Eagle" in the 7th Race on May 9th, 2025, at SunRay Park.

For this violation, the Board of Stewards issued the following:

Kevin Enriquez Arenivas (2nd offense of 2025) a fine in the amount of One Thousand Dollars, (\$1,000,00). This fine is to be paid on or before June 1st, 2025, in accordance with NMAC 15.2.1.9 (A)(7)(f). Failure to pay the fine in the prescribed time shall result in an immediate suspension.

Licensee is found to be in violation of NMAC:
