UPDATE August 20, 2025

IMPORTANT NOTICE FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE TO THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO HORSERACING INDUSTRY REGARDING EIA

August 20, 2025

Due to the unfortunate and troubling increased instances of the viral Equine Infectious Anemia (EIA) disease being diagnosed in racehorses, the State of New Mexico Racing Commission (NMRC) announce the following:

Effective Wednesday August 20, 2025, it is mandatory that all horses shipping into The Downs at Albuquerque must provide the original proof of a negative Coggins test drawn within the previous sixty (60) days in order to gain entry. NO EXCEPTIONS!!

Due to the detection of cases of EIA in racehorses housed on grounds and facilities under the regulatory jurisdiction of the NMRC, it is strongly recommended all licensees of horses currently being housed at such locations immediately contact their veterinarians to get an updated Coggins test for all such animals and retain all paperwork showing negative test results.

These procedures are necessary to protect the health and safety of the equine athletes which are the foundation of New Mexico's horseracing industry. The NMRC thanks its licensees for taking this matter seriously and for their cooperation and compliance.
