Attention horsemen

Effective November 22, 2025, any horse entering the grounds of Zia Park and the Downs at Albuquerque must have a health certificate within the last 5 days, including horses shipping from the Downs at Albuquerque and all New Mexico locations.

The temperature of the horse MUST be recorded on the CVI/Health Certificate, and the following statement must be included: "Within the last 21 days, the equids listed on this CVI have not originated from a premises currently quarantined for EHV-1, have not been exposed to EHV-1, and have not attended an event where EHV-1 has been confirmed." Failure to comply with these requirements may result in regulatory or legal action.

All horses shipping into Zia Park must have their temperature taken and recorded on the Temperature Log that will be handed out at the stable gate. Horses staying overnight must have their temperature taken twice daily and recorded.

Any horse with a temperature over 101.5 °F must be reported to the Official Veterinarian Dr. Ada Caruthers (804)347-0472. When leaving Zia Park, please submit the completed Temperature Log to the stable gate employee.
