RE: 2025-SUN-100 - Case Continued 12/30/25

Trainer/Owner Chris David Marquez having been properly noticed, appeared via Microsoft Teams for his summary suspension hearing December 30, 2025, at 12:30 P.M. in the office of the Board of Stewards' at Sunland Park (1200 Futurity Dr Sunland Park, NM, 88063), per Rule 15.2.1.9 A. (3)(a)(b) (c) Summary Suspension, regarding a medication violation on November 23, 2025, for first place finisher "Meleros Cerveza" from race 4 at Zia Park.

Sample E549388 tested positive for the drug Clenbuterol (Class 3 Penalty A drug). An affidavit from Industrial Laboratories (the official laboratory for the New Mexico Racing Commission) on December 19, 2025, reported the presence of Clenbuterol confirmed in Blood.

Additionally, Sample E549388 tested positive for the drug Ambroxol (Class 4 Penalty B drug). An affidavit from Industrial Laboratories (the official laboratory for the New Mexico Racing Commission) on December 19, 2025, reported the presence of Ambroxol confirmed in Urine.

Chris D. Marquez was listed as the Trainer of "Meleros Cerveza" on November 23, 2025.
Rodolfo Gonzalez Villar was listed as the Owner of "Meleros Cerveza" on November 23, 2025.

Split sample rights were afforded to Trainer Chris David Marquez and declined, per NMAC 15.2.6.10 D.

After hearing the testimony and viewing evidence presented, the Sunland Park Board of Stewards determined that Chris David Marquez shall remain suspended pending the outcome of his disciplinary hearing.

NMAC 16.47.1.8 (L)(1)(e)(i)(o) Grounds for disciplinary measures for a licensee, and refusal, denial, suspension, or revocation of a license: (1) The commission may refuse to issue a license to an applicant, or may suspend or revoke a license issued, or order disciplinary measures, if the applicant: (e) has been found in violation of rules governing racing in New Mexico and of other racing commissions or of any recognized regulatory organization: (i) is a person whose conduct or reputation may adversely reflect on the honesty and integrity of horse racing or interfere with the orderly conduct of a race meeting; interfering with the orderly conduct of a race meeting shall include, but is not limited to, disruptive or

intemperate behavior or behavior which exposes others to danger anywhere on the racetrack grounds; the fact that the race meet was not actually interrupted is not a defense to the imposition of discipline under this rule;

(o) has engaged in conduct unbecoming or detrimental to the best interests of racing;

NMAC 15.2.6.9 MEDICATIONS AND PROHIBITED SUBSTANCES:

B. Penalty Recommendations

C.(1) Medication Restrictions; A finding by the commission approved laboratory of a prohibited substance in an official post-race or out-of-competition sample of a horse is prima facie evidence that the prohibited substance was administered to the horse and, in the case of a post-race test, was present in the horse's body while it was participating in a race.

C.(4) There is no permissible concentration of clenbuterol or albuterol that is allowed to appear in any official sample. This includes samples collected from Quarter Horses and Thoroughbreds.

In accordance with 15.2.1.9 B. (21), Chris D. Marquez is hereby excluded from all areas of the grounds under the jurisdiction of the NMRC. Additionally, effective upon applicable suspension dates, all horses owned, trained, or under the care of Chris D. Marquez are ineligible to be entered or start in any race in this jurisdiction, per 15.2.1.9 A.(8)(b) and 15.2.1.9 B.(21)(c).

NMSA 1978, Section 60-1A-4 (A)(2) provides "The commission may exclude or compel the exclusion of a person from all horse racetracks who the commission deems detrimental to the best interest of horseracing..."

All transfers and sales of horses trained, owned, or in the care and custody of Chris D. Marquez must be done in accordance with 15.2.6.9 A.(13)(a)(b)(c)(d) Medication and Prohibited Substances, 15.2.1.9 A.(8) Due Process and Disciplinary Action, and 16.47.1.10 D. (7) Assistant Trainers.
