

The following are instructions to change the caption/subtitle of language in Microsoft Teams. The example provided is English to Spanish.


Step 1: To change caption/subtitle of language, click on the highlighted areas.

Paso 1: Para cambiar el idioma de los subtítulos, presione en las áreas subrayadas.




Step 2: Click on the highlighted areas below.

Step 3: Click on “English” dropdown box, as it will open a list of language options to choose from for the caption/subtitle.
