IMPORTANT NOTICE FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE TO THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO HORSERACING INDUSTRY REGARDING EIA

March 11, 2026

It is mandatory that all horses shipping into SunRay Park and the Downs at Albuquerque are accompanied with and provide the original proof of a negative Coggins test drawn within the previous 365 days in order to gain entry. NO EXCEPTIONS!!

Furthermore, all horses stabled at or entered to race at a New Mexico racetrack must have a current negative Coggins test drawn within the previous 365 days on file with the racing office.

These procedures are necessary to protect the health and safety of the equine athletes which are the foundation of New Mexico's horseracing industry. The NMRC thanks its licensees for taking this matter seriously and for their cooperation and compliance.
