Owner/Trainer Joel Gutierrez is hereby summarily suspended, effective immediately, April 9, 2026, pending the outcome of his summary suspension hearing scheduled April 12, 2026, at 8:30 a.m. in the office of the Board of Stewards at SunRay Park (39 Rd 5568, Farmington, NM 87401), per 15.2.1.9 A.(3)(a)(b)(c) Summary Suspension. The Summary Suspension is regarding a medication violation on March 21, 2026, for seventh place finisher #7 "Stuntin Like Daddy" from race 4 at Sunland Park.

Sample #E656813 tested positive for the drug Albuterol (Class 3 Penalty A drug). An affidavit from Industrial Laboratories (the official laboratory for the New Mexico Racing Commission) on April 7, 2026, reported Albuterol confirmed in Urine.

Joel Gutierrez was listed as the Trainer of record for the horse "Stuntin Like Daddy" on March 21, 2026.

(9) Excessive use of the crop includes:

(a) Riders cannot use the riding crop more than three times in succession during a race, excluding showing or waiving the crop.

(b) Riders cannot use the crop more than three times in succession without giving the horse a chance to respond before using the crop again.

Sample #E657116 tested positive for the drug Albuterol (Class 3 Penalty A drug). An affidavit from Industrial Laboratories (the official laboratory for the New Mexico Racing Commission) on May 6, 2026, reported Albuterol confirmed in Urine.

Jesse Le Rubio was listed as the Trainer of record for the horse "Storm Leader" on April 25, 2026.

Karina Gonzalez was listed as the Owner of record for the horse "Storm Leader" on April 25, 2026.

Trainer/Owner Lauren McQueen, having been properly notified, waived her 10-day notice and appeared via Microsoft Teams before the Sunray Park Board of Stewards (39 Rd 5568, Farmington, NM 87401) on May 9, 2026, at 8:30 AM, regarding the license suspension of Ricardo Armendariz, Jr., (NM-Ruling #2026-SRP-26 based on reciprocity), her domestic partner and member of her household, and its potential impact on her New Mexico Racing Commission (NMRC) licenses.

Testimony provided by Lauren McQueen confirmed Ricardo Armendariz, Jr., is her boyfriend, they share the same mailing address, and Mr. Armendariz stays with her, at her residence, when he is not traveling. Both Ms. McQueen and Mr. Armendariz submitted NMRC license applications with the same addresses and listed each other as emergency contacts (at the same address). Ms. McQueen testified she is aware Mr. Armendariz is suspended, and she took over the training of horses previously trained by Mr. Armendariz. Ms. McQueen testified she has 22 horses currently stabled at the Downs at Albuquerque Racetrack, a number of which were previously trained by suspended trainer Ricardo Armendariz, Jr. Ms. McQueen also testified she has not seen the horses in about 10 days, and was unable to provide the names of the two grooms who cared for the horses in her absence.

The evidence revealed that Ms. McQueen took over the training of a number of Mr. Armendariz's horses, with the knowledge he was suspended, and while they were in a domestic partner relationship.

After hearing the testimony and viewing the evidence presented, the Board of Stewards determined that Licensee is found to be in violation of NMAC:

- 15.2.1.9 A. (8)(a)(b)(c) DUE PROCESS AND DISCIPLINARY ACTION: (8) Effect of rulings.
- (a) Rulings against a licensee apply to another person if continued participation in an activity by the other person would circumvent the intent of a ruling by permitting the person to serve, in essence, as a substitute for the ineligible licensee.

The stewards may suspend the license of a person who fails to appear at a disciplinary hearing after written notice of the hearing has been sent, in compliance with this subsection.

For this violation (First offense in 2026), the Board of stewards hereby issue the following penalty:

A fine in the amount of Two Hundred Dollars. (\$200.00). This fine is to be paid on or before May 30, 2026, in accordance with NMAC 15.2.3.8 B. (3)(e). Failure to pay the fine within the prescribed time may result in immediate suspension. Pursuant to NMAC 15.2.1.9. A. (7)(f) all fines imposed by the Stewards shall be paid to the Commission within 14 days after the Ruling is issued, unless otherwise ordered.

(8) Use of riding crops. Indiscriminate use of the whip is prohibited including whipping a horse: on the head, flanks or on any other part of its body other than the shoulders or hind quarters except when necessary to control a horse; during the post parade or after the finish of the race except when necessary to control the horse; excessively or brutally causing welts or breaks in the skin; when the horse is clearly out of the race or has obtained its maximum placing; persistently even though the horse is showing no response under the riding crop; or striking another rider or horse.

(9) Excessive use of the crop includes:

(a) Riders cannot use the riding crop more than three times in succession during a race, excluding showing or waiving the crop.

(b) Riders cannot use the crop more than three times in succession without giving the horse a chance to respond before using the crop again.

The Board of Stewards hereby issue (Third offense during the 2026 Sunray Park race meet) the following penalty: A fine in the amount of **Seven Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$750.00)**. This fine is to be paid on or before May 31, 2026, in accordance with NMAC 15.2.3.8 B. (3)(e). Failure to pay the fine within the prescribed time may result in immediate suspension.
